It is not owned by a person resident in the UK

Its import does not contravene any import regulations

It is brought to the UK for public display in a temporary exhibition at a museum or gallery

The borrowing museum or gallery is approved under the Act

The borrowing museum has published information about the object

- Collection Marcantonio Doria, Genoa;
- Thence by descent through Doria descendants until 1832, when transferred to the Villa Doria d'Angri at Eboli;
- Thence by descent through the family, until the early twentieth century when sold along with the villa to the Baron Camillo Romano Avezzana (1867-1949);
- By inheritance to his wife, Felicita Romano Avezzana;
- From whom purchased on 18 March 1972, as a work by Mattia Preti, by the Banca Commerciale Italiana, now Banca Intesa, in whose collection it remains.
