

200 Creators – Terms and Conditions

These terms set out the basis upon which you can submit an expression of interest in response to the open call (each a '**EOI**'), the basis on which no more than fifty creators shall be chosen by a panel of experts to be involved in the 200 Creators Network (2025/2026) for a period of one year.

By completing an expression of interest form, you enter into a binding agreement with the National Gallery on the following terms:

1. You confirm that you are over 18, based in the UK, and that there is no legal, or other, reason to prevent you from being involved in the 200 Creators Network.
2. You confirm that you are not a current employee or contractor of the National Gallery or National Gallery Global Ltd.
3. You must submit your EOI on or before 11.59pm BST on Sunday 31 August 2025, after which time EOIs shall not be accepted. EOIs can be submitted by email to 200creators@nationalgallery.org.uk.
4. All submissions of EOIs that meet the selection criteria will be assessed by a panel of National Gallery experts. The 50 successful shortlisted creators will be invited by the Gallery by email to join the network by w/c 22 September 2025. If you are one of the 50 successful creators selected to join the Network, you will be asked to sign up to the Network membership terms. This is the basis upon which this opportunity is offered, and you acknowledge and accept that the terms of the Network membership terms are non- negotiable. If you have management or agency representation, entry into the Network Membership terms must be by you as the creator and not by your representatives.
5. If you are one of the 50 successful creators selected to join the Network you will be invited to attend the Launch Event on the evening of 27 October 2025 hosted by the National Gallery.
6. Nothing in this Agreement excludes or limits the liability of any party for death or personal injury caused by that party's negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation or any other liability which cannot be excluded or limited under applicable law. Subject to the foregoing, the National Gallery's aggregate liability to you arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, whether in tort (including negligence and breach of statutory duty, howsoever arising), breach of contract or otherwise, shall in no circumstances exceed in aggregate of the monies paid by the

National Gallery to you hereunder.

7. If you are entering into this agreement on behalf of a partnership or a company, you warrant and represent that you have the right to do so and that such other entity shall be bound by this agreement as well as you personally.
8. This agreement is governed by English Law and any dispute arising out of or in connection with this agreement shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
