




### THE GALLERY

By hosting your event with us, you will also support our key objectives to enhance and care for the collection and provide free access for generations to come.




#### THE PORTICO






### ROOM 34 THE BRITISH COLLECTION



# ANNENBERG COURT



### THE YVES SAINT LAURENT ROOM

The Yves Saint Laurent Room is an elegant gallery dedicated to Rubens, the most celebrated Flemish painter of the 17th Century. In addition to the ingenuity of his compositions and brilliant use of colour, the opulent fabric on the walls enhances the atmospheric setting.

Guided tours can also be arranged of paintings by artists including Rembrandt and Van Dyck in the adjacent rooms.

## NEW SPACES COMING SOON

In May 2024, we celebrated our 200th birthday. To commemorate this occasion, we are undergoing an ambitious capital transformation: NG200.

To mark this milestone, we are creating a meaningful legacy that will make the Gallery fit for purpose as it enters its third century.

We are reimagining our entrance and creating an exciting new Supporters House. This also comes with a full redesign of our daytime events spaces due to be completed in 2025. From our popular auditorium to a flexible meeting room and many more versatile event spaces, there is much to look forward to in 2025. Take a look!













## THE PIGOTT THEATRE

Our auditorium is returning with exciting brand new equipment and a design refresh. With the help of a dedicated team of Audio-Visual Technicians, this 300 theatre style seat auditorium can be hired for presentations, conferences, film screenings, award ceremonies, product launches and more.

We have an adjacent versatile foyer to provide space for refreshment breaks, a light lunch during and toasting the end of the event with a networking reception.

### THE WHITCOMB ROOM

On the mezzanine level, we have a versatile space for team activities, private business lunches and full-day board meetings.

It offers AV facilities, including a projector, screen, and a brand-new PA system, allowing you to create memorable moments, and fostering collaboration and productivity, in an environment designed to inspire.

### SUPPORTERS HOUSE

As part of the NG200 project, we're transforming an existing area of the main National Gallery building into a space for Supporters and Members to relax, socialise and enjoy a deeper connection.

The Supporters House will also be available for private hire out of hours and will suit more intimate gatherings, such as special occasion events and corporate entertaining for up to 100 people. It will have its own restaurant, bar, private dining room, lounge and event space. The event space will also be available during the day for venue hire. This space will be conveniently located with private access from Trafalgar Square.





### BESPOKE TOURS AND EXPERIENCES

Immerse yourself in the captivating narratives and explore the stories behind our world-famous masterpieces by booking a bespoke private tour.

With our team of expert guides and art historians, we can plan an experience that caters to your precise interests. Each tour is thoughtfully curated to align with your preferences, ensuring a personalised journey through the realms of artistic expression and history.

Our private tours offer a flexible range of options. As stand-alone experiences, they grant private access to the Gallery's treasures for the duration of up to 1 hour and suitable for up to 30 guests. These tours can also be seamlessly integrated as an addition to your event, whether it is a breakfast or evening gathering.

You can make the most of your venue hire experience at the National Gallery by letting your guests interact with the art historians, following the structure of a tour or at their own pace. For a more creative experience, organise a sketch workshop for you and your guests, so you can enjoy the peace of the Gallery out of hours and get lost in your surroundings.




### AN ICONIC LANDMARK & **LOCATION**
